After a short time playing in the park, Glenda found out about Zephyrhills Shuffleboard Club and decided she wanted to move on and learn more. She played for a year or so as an amateur. Then she started to play in Pro Tournaments getting Instant Pro 2 times in the winter of 2012. Glenda won the Amateur Reiny Masters, March 2012 in Central District. Then she started playing as a Pro in the fall.

During Glenda's Amateur time she played No 2 Pro with me. The 2<sup>nd</sup> year Pro she started to travel to some tournaments. She improved all the time. The past 2 years she has completed the season in first place for the Ladies in Central District. In 2016 Glenda won the Ladies Masters in our district. To date, Glenda has placed 1<sup>st</sup> in 14 State Tournaments. For 4 years she has finished the season in the top 8 Ladies in State.

Glenda has played in International Shuffleboard and Canadian National Shuffleboard tournaments. She is serving as 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice-president of the Canadian Shuffleboard Association.
