Mary is from Easton, Massachusetts. Extracurricular activities included basketball, cheerleading, field hockey and softball. She and Bob, her husband, spend the summertime in their camp in Gilmanton, New Hampshire, near Sawyer Lake.

In 1990, they moved to Winters Park in Zephyrhills, FL. Both took shuffleboard lessons and their shuffle careers began. Her first trophy was earned in 1992. Mary made Pro in February 1995. The year before, she had played in the Reiny Masters tournament. In 1996 the Christensen's moved to Betmar Park with their covered courts. She has played nine other times in the District Masters, taking first place twice, most recently in 2011.

Mary's most memorable amateur tournament was a 1995 first place win with her partner, Marshall Leigh, in a 89-team event at Woodall's Park in Lakeland. She played a critically special tournament with Dean Myklejord on January 9, 2014, at Sanlan in Lakeland, yielding the coveted last point for the Central District Hall of Fame status.
